

Pulaski / Giles County Airport



Runway 16/34 is 5310ft. long by 75 ft. wide asphalt in excellent condition. New medium intensity runway edge lights are always on at night and are adjustable via a pilot-controlled, radio-activated system. Both ends of the runway have PAPIs, which keep landing pilots on a safe glide path, and REILs, which are strobes that help pilots locate the ends of the runway when visibility is poor.

Runway 34 has a GPS RNAV / LPV approach with 250 ft minimums for WAAS equipped aircraft. Runway 34 also has a VOR/DME approach. Runway 16 has a GPS RNAV approach. We have a NEXWAS automated weather station located on the airport. Pilots can obtain current weather at the airport by listening on frequency 118.275 or by calling 931-363-6760.

A courtesy phone is available in the outer lobby for local and toll free calls. The pilot's lounge has comfortable La-Z-Boy furniture, cable television, microwave and a small fridge. Pilots have access to a computer for weather briefing and flight planning and wi-fi is available for use with laptops and iPads. Free ice is available as is a vehicle for pilots to get into town for lunch.

Our terminal building is attached to the original storage hanger that was built when the airport was first developed. It has a modern, well furnished lobby with a comfortable conference seating area, a pilot's lounge and a shower is provided in the men's restroom. There is an outer lobby that is open 24 hours with vending machines and a comfortable table and chairs.

We have three aircraft storage hangers at our airport. The original hanger has 6400 ft.² of storage space, the blue metal hanger has 7000 ft.² of storage space and the tan large hanger has 14,400 ft.² of storage space plus 2000 ft.² of offices or classrooms. Our new

classroom (pictured bottom right) is utilized for pilot ground school classes and meetings. Flight and ground school training are offered for single and multi-engine airplanes for anyone interested in learning to fly. For those individuals or businesses with travel needs, a Piper Aztec twin engine, six seat aircraft is available on an hourly lease basis.

overnight hanger storage can be rented on a space-available basis. A licensed aircraft mechanic is available by prior arrangement. A forklift is available for freight handling and trucking can be arranged as needed. All services are available 24 hours on request.

Fueling services are available for aircraft using 100 Low Lead (over wing) and Jet A (over wing and single point). Oil is available in a variety of viscosities for piston engine aircraft and 2380 oil is available for turbine powered aircraft. Tie downs are provided for visiting aircraft at no charge and
